The **Enhancing Teaching & Learning** conference is a **KCPDC** professional development activity that provides an opportunity for educators from member institutions to share their successes in the classroom. Through concurrent 50-minute sessions, presenters are encouraged to be creative in an attempt to appeal to a broad audience. Presenters receive stipends of \$100. There are three conference tracks or themes to consider:

1. ***The Scholarship of Teaching and Learning***: Inspired by Dr. Ernest Boyer, examples would include: educational research, action research, tests of educational methodologies, or curriculum evaluation.
2. ***Technology in the Classroom***: Do you use technology in the classroom? Examples might include: new technology, effective use of the Internet in the classroom, or making technology an effective part of teaching.
3. ***Engaging Students***: How do you do it? Examples may include: increasing student interaction, techniques for making learning fun

- **Your name and contact information.** Include your institution, academic department, business address, business phone number, fax number, and e-mail address. If you will have co-presenter(s), please send the same information for your colleague(s).
- **Title and a 120-word summary/description of your proposed presentation.** This should be suitable for inclusion in the conference program. Keep in mind that the most successful sessions have been interactive, hands-on presentations.
