REQUIREMENTS FOR FRESHMAN ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Students must be admitted to Park University's Parkville Daytime Campus Center to be awarded an academic scholarship. Scholarship funding is limited and will be awarded until funds are exhausted. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents. The scholarship is awarded to freshmen and is available for four years if renewal criteria are met.

A seventh semester high school transcript must be received before scholarships can be officially awarded. A student may not receive more than one academic scholarship.

Academic scholarships are available for fall and spring only. Students must be full-time to be eligible to receive an academic scholarship.

- Top applicants who have submitted all admission and scholarship materials by January 20, 2012, will be invited to participate in the February 4, 2012, Scholarship Day. Students will be notified by January 30, 2012.
- Top applicants who have submitted all admission and scholarship materials by February 17, 2012, will be invited to participate in the March 3, 2012, Scholarship Day. Students will be notified by February 27, 2012.

Trustee Scholarship (\$7,500)

Eligibility criteria: (2 of 3 required)

- 3.75 cumulative high school grade point average or 3200 GED score
- 28 ACT or 1860 SAT score
- Class rank in top 10 percent

Renewal criteria:

- Must maintain 3.25 GPA
- Available for a maximum of four years
- Must complete 24 credit hours each academic year (fall and spring)

Founders Scholarship (\$5,000)

Eligibility criteria: (2 of 3 required)

- 3.5 cumulative high school GPA or 3000 GED score
- 26 ACT or 1760 SAT score
- Class rank in top 15 percent

Renewal criteria:

- Must maintain 3.0 GPA
- Available for a maximum of four years
- Must complete 24 credit hours each academic year (fall and spring)

Hundley-Volker Scholarship (\$2,500)

Eligibility criteria: (2 of 3 required)

- 3.25 cumulative high school GPA or 2800 GED score
- 24 ACT or 1650 SAT score
- Class rank in top 25 percent

Renewal criteria:

- Must maintain 2.5 GPA
- Available for a maximum of four years
- Must complete 24 credit hours each academic year (fall and spring)

Park A-Plus Recognition Scholarship (\$5,000)

Eligibility criteria:

- Attend an A-Plus-eligible high school (must provide a letter of eligibility from your high school counselor) AND
- 3.25 cumulative high school GPA
- OR
- 24 ACT or 1650 SAT score

Renewal criteria:

- Must maintain 3.0 GPA
- Available for a maximum of four years
- Must complete 24 credit hours each academic year (fall and spring)
