

REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSFER ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Students must be admitted to Park University’s Parkville Daytime Campus Center, Austin Campus Center, Kansas City Area, Wentworth Campus Center or DIST (online non-military) to be awarded an academic scholarship. All transcripts must be received, and the total grade point average will be calculated based on all previous coursework. Deadline is February 1 for receipt of scholarship application and required documents. Scholarship funding is limited and scholarships will be awarded until funds are exhausted. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents. Students may not receive more than one academic tuition scholarship or grant.

Academic scholarships are available for fall and spring only, and will pay for a maximum of 30 credit hours per academic year. Students must be full-time to be eligible to receive an academic scholarship.

**Trustee Transfer Scholarship
(100 percent tuition)**

Eligibility criteria:

- 3.9 or higher cumulative grade point average with a minimum of 60 transferable college hours from an accredited institution

Renewal criteria:

- Must maintain a 3.9 cumulative GPA
- Available for a maximum of 2½ years
- Must complete 24 credit hours each academic year (fall and spring)

**Founders Transfer Scholarship
(75 percent tuition)**

Eligibility criteria:

- 3.75 or higher cumulative GPA with a minimum of 24 transferable college hours from an accredited institution

Renewal criteria:

- Must maintain 3.75 cumulative GPA
- Available for a maximum of 3½ years
- Must complete 24 credit hours each academic year (fall and spring)

**Presidents Transfer Scholarship
(50 percent tuition)**

Eligibility criteria:

- 3.5 GPA or higher cumulative GPA with a minimum of 24 transferable college hours from an accredited institution

Renewal criteria:

- Must maintain 3.5 cumulative GPA
- Available for a maximum of 3½ years
- Must complete 24 credit hours each academic year (fall and spring)

**Hundley-Volker Transfer Scholarship
(25 percent tuition)**

Eligibility criteria:

- 3.25 GPA or higher cumulative GPA with a minimum of 24 transferable college hours from an accredited institution

Renewal criteria:

- Must maintain 3.25 cumulative GPA
- Available for a maximum of 3½ years
- Must complete 24 credit hours each academic year (fall and spring)
