Teaching Tip

Many faculty question how they can implement new technology trends into their online and face-to-face classes. Campus Technology recently published a list by two experts of their top 18 Web 2.0 Tools for Instruction (<http://campustechnology.com/articles/2010/05/01/18-web-20-tools-for-instruction.aspx>). Many of these top expert picks are free or low-cost with a premium or membership option.

In addition to these expert picks, the Centre for Learning & Performance Technologies (C4LPT) in the UK surveyed 278 learning professionals worldwide for their top ten learning tools. The responses gathered were compiled into a list of the Top 100 Tools for Learning 2009 (<http://www.c4lpt.co.uk/recommended/>). Many of the items on this list are free or low-cost with a premium option.
