How to Get a Driver's License/ Permit

What you need:

1. Driver's License Letter from International Student Services
2. Passport
3. I-94 Card
4. Form I-20
5. Social Security Card
 - a. You will be required to obtain a letter from Social Security Office if you do not have a Social Security Card.
6. Application Fee (\$5—\$20)

Step One: Written/Driving Test

1. Highway Patrol Office—this is where you can take your written and driving test.
2. You have to take and pass the written test (25 multiple-choice questions) before you can take the driving test.
3. You can get a free Missouri Driver Guide booklet to help you study for the written test. You can also get the Missouri Driver Guide online at http://dor.mo.gov/forms/Driver_Guide.pdf
4. Please note that you must have a car that you can drive in order to take the driving test. A car will NOT be provided for you.

Step Two: Driver's License/Permit

1. Driving License Bureau—this is where you can get your driving permit or driver's license.
2. If you purchase a car, this is also where you can get your license plates, title and registration.
