## McAfee Scholarship for Freshmen

This top scholarship covers the cost of your tuition for up to 36 credit hours each academic year (August-May), as well as room and board at the double occupancy rate. Scholarship recipients must intend to live on campus.

### Eligibility criteria:

- 3.75 cumulative high school grade point average (GPA) or 3200 GED score; and
- 28 ACT or 1860 SAT score

### Renewal criteria:

- Must maintain a 3.75 cumulative grade point average
- Available for a maximum of four years
- Must complete 24 credit hours each academic year (fall and spring)

### STUDY-ABROAD OPPORTUNITY

Recipients of the Park McAfee Scholarship will be awarded a one-time stipend for the Park University Study Abroad Program. This opportunity can be taken any time after attaining sophomore status.

## The Application Process

- Top applicants who have submitted all admission and scholarship materials that are received by February 1, 2010, will be invited to attend the Park McAfee Scholarship Competition on the Parkville Campus.
- Students selected to compete in the finalist competition on campus will be notified by February 5, 2010. The Park McAfee Scholarship Competition will be held on February 13, 2010.
- The Scholarship Competition Day includes a tour of the campus, an interview with the Scholarship Committee and an essay competition. During the day, the competitors will also have an opportunity to learn about the Degree with Honors Program ([www.park.edu/honors](http://www.park.edu/honors)).
- Notification for scholarships awarded following the scholarship competition will be mailed by March 5, 2010.
- Applicants who have submitted all admission and scholarship materials (received by February 1, 2010) and who are not invited to attend the Park McAfee Scholarship Competition will be considered for other freshman scholarships.
