

# The Pat Hutchens McClelland Endowed Scholarship

THE FINANCIAL AID STAFF will award the funds in accordance with the criteria established by the donor. Use of the funds must be in accordance with established financial policies at Park University. All efforts will be made to carry out the wishes of name of donor in using the fund.

DISTRIBUTIONS FROM THE PAT HUTCHENS MCCLELLAND ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FOR EDUCATION will be used to support the tuition costs of students who are pursuing an undergraduate degree in elementary or secondary education. Students must be enrolled in Park University either as a full-time or part-time student and be in good academic standing. He/she must demonstrate academic competence with a minimum grade point average of 3.0 in his/her education courses; be making normal progress toward graduation; have a demonstrated financial need and meet all other regular qualifications for financial aid at Park University. Two letters of recommendation and a personal essay outlining the applicant's accomplishments and community services activities (not to exceed 500 words) must accompany the scholarship application. Preference will be given to applicants who plan to teach in urban school districts and who are from an ethnic or racial background typically underrepresented in higher education. If there are no applicants who fit these award guidelines, awards may be given to students from the Marshall Islands. Each recipient of a scholarship awarded from the fund shall be designated a PAT HUTCHENS MCCLELLAND SCHOLAR.
