

## MARLOWE SHERWOOD ALUMNI ASSOCIATION ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP NEW FOR 07-08 \$500.00 TO ONE STUDENT

In recognition of 14 years as the Park University alumni director, the Park University Alumni Council established this scholarship in her memory. At the time of her death, she had been involved with Park alumni for nearly 40 years. This endowment was established to honor her love of Park University and its alumni by providing scholarships to alumni or those related to alumni as a spouse, child, grandchild, sibling, nephew or niece.

From 1946-47, Marlowe and Paul '47 Sherwood served as house parents at Woodward Hall while Paul finished his degree. Years later Marlowe returned to Park as an adult student and graduated in 1963 with a degree in Art, magna cum laude. After her graduation, she was elected to the Executive Council of the Alumni Association and in 1966 she volunteered to edit the Alumniad. She was hired as alumni director in 1969 and held that position full time, part time or voluntarily until her retirement in 1985.

Marlowe was also a member in long standing of the Park University Friends of the Library and held the office of treasurer of the Park University Historical Society since its founding in 1984. She was honored as a Distinguished Alumna in 1980, the highest award given by the Alumni Association.

### CRITERIA

- 1) Applicant must be alumni or related as a spouse, child, grandchild, sibling, nephew (blood relative, not in-law) or niece (blood relative, not in-law). Applicants need to provide the name and relationship to alumni.
- 2) Applicant must be officially admitted to Park University. Applicant may be full time or part time, traditional or non-traditional, undergraduate or graduate at any Park University campus or program.
- 3) Applicant must be in good academic standing with a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average, making normal progress towards graduation, and meet all other regular qualifications for financial aid at Park University.
- 4) This scholarship will be awarded for a single academic year, and must be used within the academic year. The award is not automatically renewable, however recipients may reapply for this award in subsequent years.

Students may apply for this scholarship by completing the Park University Endowed Scholarship Application on the Park University website in the financial aid section, along with the Autobiography/Personal Statement and submitting two letters of recommendation. Applicants should specifically indicate in the autobiography/personal statement that this is the award they are interested in.
