

Moser-Schaible Award:

RECIPIENT QUALIFICATIONS: The Book Fund Scholarship was created to assist students with the high cost of textbooks and study materials. Many international students do not purchase texts until well into the semester because they exhaust their funds in the first few days of the semester on housing and transportation. In other cases, international students often do not have experience purchasing books for courses before arriving in the United States and so do not budget for this expense. Even those who have purchased books in their home countries or schools find the quantity and cost of course texts to be beyond their expectations. Individuals eligible to receive the award:

- International student, with first preference for students from the countries of El Salvador, Armenia, Vietnam, and Zimbabwe (in this order). If no students from these countries apply, then next preference is for students for any other international country, preferably from a developing nation. If no international students apply, then the award may be made to a student from the United States.
- Enrolled as a full-time or part time student
- 2.9 GPA or higher

If the student drops a course for which books were purchased, he/she must refund their book award. The book award, consisting of the annual income from the fund, will be awarded to one or more students each calendar year. The students who are selected to receive the award may apply for the book fund again. If no student qualifies for the book fund in a given year, the fund earnings shall be returned to the principal of the fund.
