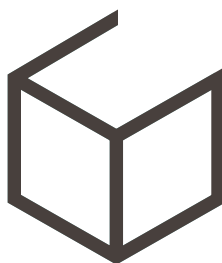

PARK UNIVERSITY OFFERS A WIDE RANGE OF TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS.

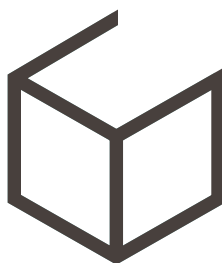

ASSOCIATES DEGREE RECOGNITION SCHOLARSHIP

(\$1,000 Annually)

(\$1,000 Annually)

Completion of minimum 24 credit hours from an accredited Kansas public 2-year institution

(\$500 Annually)
