Helpful information

When completing the Itemization Worksheet, please remember that while you may be living with friends or relatives and not paying for your living expenses, the Federal regulations require that these costs be accounted as sources of support.

The Itemization Worksheet form asks you to outline how you supported yourself (and your family if applicable) in 2019 by providing the cost of your expenses monthly and also how you covered those expenses. You may need to estimate what the costs would be IF you were being charged and then enter this amount of support you are receiving the source.

For example, if you lived rent free in 2019, you would still need to explain what your portion of the rent would have been IF you had been charged:

- If you lived somewhere with 3 other people (4 total living together) and the monthly rent/mortgage was \$1200, your portion monthly would be \$300. ($\$1200/4 = \300)
- You would then show this as support from whomever was providing the housing as “Support from relatives or friends” or “Other”.

We will not be able to move forward with your verification until we receive the Itemization Worksheet completed with costs or estimates of costs and the sources of support.
