Frequently Asked Questions

- What is Park's admissions rate? Park University is an open-admissions institution at the undergraduate level and so does not report admissions rates.
- How many student-athletes are at Park? For 2021-2022 EADA Survey, we reported 693 student-athletes: 341 at Parkville and 352 at Gilbert.
- What is Park's Carnegie Classification? Park's Carnegie classifications (2021) are as follows:
 - Basic: Master's Colleges & Universities: Larger Programs;
 - *Undergraduate Instructional Program:* Professions focus, some graduate coexistence;
 - *Graduate Instructional Program:* Postbaccalaureate: Business-dominant, with Arts & Sciences;
 - Enrollment Profile: High undergraduate;
 - Undergraduate Profile: Four-year, higher part-time;
 - Size and Setting: Four-year, medium, primarily nonresidential.
- How many began as new undergraduates in fall? In Fall 2021, there were 321 first-time students (254 full-time, 67 part-time) and 706 new transfer students (371 full-time, 335 part-time). Source: 2021-2022 IPEDS Fall Enrollment Survey.
- How many employees does Park have? In fall 2021: 461 full-time employees and 850 part-time employees including adjunct. Source: 2021-2022 IPEDS Human Resources Survey.
- What kinds of financial support do students receive? In 2020-2021, thirty-four percent of undergraduates were awarded Pell grants (average: \$3,948); thirty percent of undergraduates received Federal Student Loans (average \$6,919). Of the subset of those who were full-time first-time degree-seeking students, forty-nine percent were awarded Pell grants (average: \$4,977) and fifty-seven percent received Federal Student Loans (average: \$5,553). Eighty-eight percent of full-time first-time students receive some kind of aid. Source: 2021-2022 IPEDS Student Financial Aid survey (Fall 2020 cohort data).
- What are the totals for graduates and programs completed? In 2021-2022, there were 2,313 total unduplicated graduates: 81 students were awarded 90 undergraduate certificates, 156 students were awarded 156 associate's degrees, 1,560 students were awarded 1,567 bachelor's degrees (with 1,586 majors), 1 student was awarded an Artist Diploma, 539 students were awarded 539 master's degrees, and 6 students were awarded 6 Educational Specialist degrees.
- What is the graduation rate? The latest published Overall Graduation Rate is 24%. The transfer-out rate is 37%. The graduation rate for the Bachelor's Cohort is 25%. Source: 2021-2022 IPEDS Graduation Rates Survey (Fall 2015 incoming cohort).
- What are the most popular majors? The most popular major areas for bachelor's degree completers are Business/Management (all areas) (43.5%), Psychology (all areas) (13.9%), Information Systems and Computer Science (all areas) (10.2%), Criminal Justice Administration (all areas) (8.7%) and Interdisciplinary Studies (all areas) (4.4%).
- What is Park's retention rate? The latest published Retention Rate is 57% for first-time full-time students and 36% for first-time part-time students. Source: 2021-2022 Fall Enrollment Survey (Fall 2015 incoming cohort).
- What states are represented? States with the most students (fall 2022) are Missouri (1800+) and Texas (1200+). Forty-nine states are represented.
- What is the 12-month unduplicated headcount? The 12-month unduplicated headcount for 2021-2022 is 11,766. The 12-month full-time equivalency (FTE) is 5,685.
