The AAS in Accounting at JCCC transfers to Park University with the opportunity to take additional credit hours that transfer in to meet degree requirements. A maximum of 75 hours from all two-year schools can be applied toward a Park undergraduate degree with residency requirement of 30 hours at Park with 15 hours in major core.

**TRANSFER STUDENT ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:**

You must have a cumulative 2.0 GPA in all previous college study. You must submit all transcripts from prior college work completed.

If you’ve earned less than 60 hours of college credit, must also submit an official high school transcript or GED.
