FIRST DESTINATIONS, BACHELOR'S DEGREE GRADUATES

This report provides information about the "first destinations" of recent Park University graduates. Data was collected through Park's First Destination Survey using Handshake and web database pulls. The survey gathers information about where graduates' first-destination is within six months of graduating with a Bachelor's degree. Park began using the National Association for Career Education (NACE) standards for the survey in spring 2019 and adopted Handshake as a first-destination survey collection tool in fall 2023.
