1. **Purpose of Articulation of Agreement.** This Agreement facilitates Soldiers from the USAES to earn credit toward the following Associate and Bachelor of Science degree programs offered by Park University:

Soldiers will be granted the above degrees upon the completion of the remaining courses needed to achieve 60 or 120 semester hours agreed upon in the desired degree plan. The USAES and Park University curriculums were evaluated to ensure educational quality, comparability of nature, content and level of learning experiences, as well as experiences appropriate and applicable to the students' educational goals.

### 4. Program.

- a. **Registration.** Soldier participation is voluntary. Soldiers who wish to participate in the Park University Cooperative Degree Program (CDP) must register and have their credits evaluated from their Joint Services Transcripts (JST) during the application phase.
- b. **Funding.** Park University will ensure participating Soldiers are aware of all fees and charges before they register. Soldiers who participate are personally responsible for paying all costs associated with their participation. This agreement does not establish any additional programs wherein the Army or USAES will fund a Soldier's participation. Soldiers who participate are responsible for determining their eligibility for Tuition Assistance or other official educational benefits.
- c. **Course Credit and Degree Plans.** This program is designed to assist participating Soldiers with obtaining a degree from Park University by obtaining academic credit from their military education and experience. This program includes the following degree programs: Associate of Science - Construction Management, Bachelor of Science - Construction Management, Bachelor of Science – Geography,

and Bachelor of Science - Geography w/GIS minor. To obtain a degree, participating Soldiers must complete all additional general education courses, elective courses, and core courses required for the degree. Annex A identifies the available degree programs and the amount of credit that can be earned toward it from each commissioned, warrant, noncommissioned officer, and professional military education course.

d. **Program Commitment.** Park University commits to providing eligible Soldiers the credit as outlined in the attached Annex. Once a Soldier enrolls, the number and type of credit outlined in the Annex at the time of enrollment will not change to the detriment of the Soldier. Once the Soldier pays all associated costs, the appropriate credit will be added to the Soldier's official Park University transcript. The USAES commits to advertising this agreement at appropriate Education Centers as well as on appropriate websites as permitted by Army regulations and policy.

## 5. Admission Requirement.

a. Participants must submit an application and be accepted to Park University in order to participate in this CDP.

b. All participants should consult the academic policies and procedures section of the current Park University Undergraduate Catalog in reference to current academic policies.

6. **Effective Date and Termination.** This Agreement takes effect beginning on the day after the last Party signs and supersedes/cancels the previously signed Agreement between the same Parties with the same subject, Agreement #W90GZM-19-008, and effective date of 22 October 2019. The Agreement expires three years after the last Party signs, unless otherwise amended. It will be reviewed annually in its entirety. This Agreement may be modified by the written agreement of the Parties, duly signed by their authorized representatives. This Agreement may be terminated by either Party by giving at least 60 days written notice to the other Party. It may also be terminated at any time upon the mutual written consent of the Parties.
