Park University will accept a maximum of 6 hours toward a certificate, 30 hours towards an associates degree, and 60 hours toward a bachelors degree from alternative sources of credit. This credit may come from any combination of general or subject exams from CLEP, DSST, AP Exams, or from courses offered by non-accredited entities (e.g., Straighterline, Sophia, Study.com etc.), providing that credit is recommended by ACE.

Courses with the following correlations will only fulfill the ELECTIVE area of a degree audit:

BI- Biology; CH- Chemistry; EN-English; AR- Art; CJ- Criminal Justice; NS= Natural Science; HU- Humanities; SS- Social Science; CS- Computer Science; ML- Modern Language; NDE- No Direct Equivalency

Courses with an "LE000X" correlation will fulfill specific Liberal Education areas of a students degree audit: Ex. LE000H- fulfills the Liberal Education Humanities area
