FAST FACTS, FALL 2024

Park University offers 11 undergraduate certificates, 9 associate's-degree majors, 46 bachelor's-degree majors, 13 graduate certificates, 10 master's-degree majors, and 1 educational specialist degree.

FALL 2024

- Total headcount: 5,736
- Enrollment by level and intensity:
 - 4,657 undergraduates (2,511 full-time, 2,146 part-time)
 - 1,079 graduate students (171 full-time, 908 part-time)
- **DEMOGRAPHICS**
 - Undergraduate:
 - 54 percent (2,511) are full-time; 46 percent (2,146) are part-time.
 - 98 percent (4,555) are degree-seeking; 2 percent (102) are non-degree seeking
 - Our reported undergraduate gender distribution is 56% male and 44% female.
 - 60 percent of undergraduate students fall into a race/ethnicity category other than white. This includes American Indian or Alaska Native, Asian, Black/African American, Hispanic or Latino, Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander; as well as students who report two or more races, whose race/ethnicity are unknown, or who are international students on an F-1 Visa.
 - The average age for undergraduate students is 29.
 - Graduate Students:
 - 16 percent (171) are full-time; 84 percent (908) are part-time.
 - Our reported graduate gender distribution is 48% male and 52% female.
 - 73 percent of graduate students fall into a race/ethnicity category other than white. This includes American Indian or Alaska Native, Asian, Black/African American, Hispanic or Latino, Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander; as well as students who report two or more races, whose race/ethnicity are unknown, or who are international students on an F-1 Visa.
 - The average age for graduate students is 34.
- **MILITARY AFFILIATION:** 45 percent of all students have some affiliation with the military (whether as active-duty servicemembers, veterans, spouses, or dependents). Branches for active-duty servicemembers and veterans: Air Force (58%), Army (19%), Marines (16%), Unknown or other (7%).
- **INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ON F-1 VISA:**
 - We have 508 international students on an F-1 Visa. They represent 70 countries. The ten countries with the highest population are Ghana, Kenya, India, Brazil, Nepal, Italy, Columbia, Germany, Chili, and Canada.
